Project Title: Schieder Project (Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-43918-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Clear Lake, in the County of Lake, State of California; Latitude 38.99926, Longitude -122.69775 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees), 11380 North Drive, Clearlake, CA 95422; Assessor's Parcel Number 036-091-006-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-43918-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Richard Schieder.

The project is limited to the installation of one (1) 8-inch diameter steel pile intended to serve as a foundational support for a portable watercraft lift system. The pile will be driven into the lakebed with the aid of a crane positioned on a barge. An aluminum H-beam track will be securely affixed to the steel piling to increase the overall stability and functionality of the watercraft lift system. The project is expected to be completed within 10 days of the start date. No native vegetation will be removed as a result of project activities.


Exempt Status:

Categorical Exemption. Type – Class (1 – 4); California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections (1530115304)

Reasons why project is exempt:

Class 1 because the repair and maintenance involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. Class 2 because the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity. Class 3 because the project consists of construction of new small facilities and structures. Class 4 because the project is a minor alteration to Clear Lake and does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, or scenic trees.
