Project Location: The Project is located within the Freshwater Creek watershed, approximately two miles east of the City of Eureka, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Sections 29 and 32, T05N, R01E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Arcata South U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; latitude 40.78156 N and longitude 124.09024 W.

Project Description: On 11/29/2023, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Number EPIMS-HUM-39331-R1C pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602 for the Project, which will be carried out by the Northcoast Regional Land Trust in partnership with the Humboldt County Department of Public Works. The Project involves rerouting Wood Creek, constructing a new channel network, filling an existing agricultural drainage ditch, installing large wood features, creating off-channel habitat, and planting native species. CDFW expects that the Project will restore ecological function and natural processes, which will thereby benefit native fish and wildlife species.
