The Project also includes, approximately 8,000 square feet of restaurant space, and approximately 5,200 square feet of retail space, resulting in a total floor area of approximately 290,900 square feet and a floor area ratio (FAR) of approximately 3.92:1 upon completion of the Project. Additionally, the Project would include approximately 41,500 square feet of uncovered outdoor areas throughout the Project Site that include exterior office space, outdoor dining space, a rooftop deck and an outdoor amenity deck.
