**Project Title:** Stillwater Creek Tributary Crossing Upgrade (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement, EPIMS-SHA-33046-R1I)

**Project Location:** The project is located at an unnamed stream approximately 0.6 miles upstream of its confluence with Stillwater Creek in Shasta County; Latitude 40.588912, Longitude -122.313499; 20035 Old Alturas Road, Redding, CA 96003; Assessor's Parcel Number 077-080-021-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SHA-33046-R1I, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Eddie Axner Construction, as represented by Chris Manteiga.

The scope of activities authorized by this Agreement is limited to the replacement of an undersized, damaged culverted stream crossing. The existing crossing consists of three side-by-side 24-inch corrugated metal pipe (CMP) culverts set in a masonry and concrete headwall. The existing CMPs are damaged, corroded, and the headwall exhibits erosional damage. The 24-inch CMPs will be replaced with new 24-inch CMPs, and an additional 24-inch CMP will be added to better accommodate stormflows and match an existing culverted crossing just upstream of the Project site. Additionally, repairs to the headwall will be made to stabilize the structure, and additional rock slop protection will be added.
