

NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Pursuant to the State of California Public Resources Code and the "Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970" as amended to date, this is to advise you that the Butte County Department of Public Works has prepared an Initial Study for the following project:

Project Title: Central House Road Bridge Replacement Project over Wyman Ravine 12C-0111

Lead Agency: Butte County Department of Public Works

Project Description: The proposed project will replace the existing bridge on Central House Road over Wyman Ravine. The proposed project involves removing the existing structure and replacing it with a two-span bridge approximately 200 feet long (two spans at approximately 100 feet each) with an approximate 28-foot-wide roadway clear width between bridge railings. The proposed width will help accommodate farm equipment crossing the structure. A temporary creek crossing would be placed to the north of the existing bridge during construction to provide access around the bridge construction and maintaining access to properties on Central House Road. The new bridge would provide adequate and safe public access that is consistent with County, Federal Highway Administration, American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, and the California Department of Transportation design criteria and standards.

Environmental Effects: The Initial Study (IS) identified potentially significant impacts to biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, public services, transportation, tribal cultural resources, and wildfire. Environmental analysis determined that measures were available to mitigate potential adverse impacts to insignificant levels. Mitigations identified in the IS designed for the proposed project will reduce the impacts to less than significant levels. As a result, a Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) has been prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080(c), 21063.5, and Article 6 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

Public Review: The Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) has been prepared for the proposed project in accordance with CEQA (CEQA Guidelines Section 15071). The public review period for this IS/MND begins on December 8, 2023 and ends on January 9, 2024, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15072 and 15073. Project-related environmental review documents have been distributed to the California State Clearinghouse and are also available for County Drive. Comments on the IS/MND will be received by the Butte County Department of Public Works at the address above and must be received by 4 PM on January 9, 2024.
