The proposed project involves removing the existing structure and replacing it with a two-span bridge approximately 200 feet long (two spans at approximately 100 feet each) with an approximate 28-foot-wide roadway clear width between bridge railings. The proposed width will help accommodate farm equipment crossing the structure. A temporary creek crossing would be placed to the north of the existing bridge during construction to provide access around the bridge construction and maintaining access to properties on Central House Road. The new bridge would provide adequate and safe public access that is consistent with County, Federal Highway Administration, American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, and the California Department of Transportation design criteria and standards.
