The City of Susanville has hired a consultant team to work with city planning staff to update the Land Use and Circulation Elements of the existing City of Susanville General Plan. The intent of the General Plan Element updates is to provide a snapshot of how the city could grow in the future and how the land use classifications would look. The proposed project environmental status pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is exempt for the Land Use Element and a Negative Declaration has been prepared for the Circulation Element.

The developable areas and circulation system described in the previous General Plan remain as the available developable land and circulation framework in the 2023 update.
