**Project Title:** Star Bend Boat Ramp (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YUB-47544-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at the Star Bend Boat Ramp on the Feather River, a tributary to the Sacramento River, in the County of Yuba, State of California; Latitude 39.010042° N, Longitude -121.581111° W (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number APN No. 016-010-017-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YUB-47544-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sam Bunton.

The project consists of mechanical removal of 2,000 cubic yards of sediment from an established Star Bend Boat Ramp along the shore of the Feather River, done to restore the usability and functionality of the ramp.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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- 6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
