Project Title: TD2081578 Dailey Pole and Anchor Removal Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-KER-38357-R4)

Project Location: The Project will occur at one location within an unnamed tributary to Walker Basin Creek, at the intersection of Glen Oak Road and Dailey Road, east of Caliente Bodfish Road, approximately 26 miles east of the City of Bakersfield, Kern County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 398-230-01; Latitude 35.424040 North, Longitude -118.527158 West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-KER-38357-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the applicant, Southern California Edison Company.

The Project activities include the removal of one 40-foot long, one-foot diameter deteriorated wood pole (Pole 4445818E) and associated screw anchor. The Project area will be accessed by Glen Oak Road/Sample Road.
