**Project Description:** Pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1652, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife has approved the Sycamore Basin Downstream Restoration Project submitted by the California Department of Parks and Recreation, as represented by Akiko Masuda.

Existing conditions within the Project site include denuded understory vegetation, exposed tree roots, and geomorphic instability. The Project includes activities pertaining to stream recontour and stabilization, exclusionary no-climb fencing installation, and revegetation within a 1.3-acre Project footprint. The work proposed is expected to stabilize the stream, protect the Project site from off-road vehicle damage, and increase habitat complexity.
