Environmental Determination

Introduction

The City of Lakeport proposes to adopt a Class 1 Categorical Exemption (CE) for the proposed sidewalk project located on portions of South Main Street. The State California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301 states that a Class 1 CE applies to the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. This includes the following:

Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety), and other alterations such as the addition of bicycle facilities, including but not limited to bicycle parking, bicycle-share facilities and bicycle lanes, transit improvements such as bus lanes, pedestrian crossings, street trees, and other similar alterations that do not create additional automobile lanes)


Project Description

The proposed Project includes repairing and installing new sidewalk throughout portions of South Main Street between D street and Lupoyoma Avenue. The project site is developed with an existing paved two-lane road with partial sidewalks on the east and west side of Main Street. The attached map shows the locations of the project site(s). The improvements will enhance sidewalk connectivity for the pedestrians of the City of Lakeport.

The longest continuous section of sidewalk proposed is approximately 320 feet which is identified as Location 4 on the attached plan. Minor grading will be required to stabilize the proposed sidewalk.

Conclusion

The proposed project is considered minor alterations (Under Section 15301 of CEQA) as the proposed project entails minor modifications to existing infrastructure, involving the repair and extension of existing sidewalks along the site's existing street. This will create a continuous sidewalk network, eliminating gaps and enhancing pedestrian accessibility.
