- If regulated species or burrows are observed within buffer distances, stop work, and contact Resident Engineer. RE will contact Caltrans Biology unit for direction.
- If regulated species ae observed during construction a no-work buffer may be implemented at the direction of the Caltrans Biology unit. Any no-work buffer will be lifted as determined y the Caltrans Biology unit.
- All nests, burrows, and Joshua tree individuals if found within the buffer distance will be flagged for avoidance.
- Staging of materials and equipment may only occur in previously unvegetated and disturbed areas with compacted soils. Staging area locations must be approved by Caltrans Environmental staff prior to use.

Hazardous Waste:

 SSP 14-11.4 for Treated Wood Waste: The TWW will require special handling and disposal procedures as well as an EPA Generator ID # for tracking. Contractor will request this number from the Caltrans Resident Engineer at the start of construction.

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
