**Project Title:** Read Mooring Buoys (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-43911-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Lake Tahoe, in the County of Placer, State of California; 39.181814° North, Longitude 120.111409° West, 2870 Lake Terrace Avenue, Tahoe City, CA 96145

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-43911-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Laura Read.

The project consists of the placement of two new mooring buoys in Lake Tahoe, offshore of the same parcel, by means of a barge mounted crane which will lower the anchor blocks, with chains and buoys attached, to the lakebed.


