**Project Title:** Wolf Creek, Wattenberg Project Creek Realignment (Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-1998-0227-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located on Wolf Creek at Latitude 40.141323° North, Longitude 120.957673° West; 236 Greenville Wolf Creek Road, Greenville, CA 95947.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-1998-0227-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Eric Wattenberg.

This extension modifies the Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement term from December 31, 2023 to December 31, 2028. The project is limited to the redistribution of excess gravel deposited within the channel of Wolf Creek by high winter flows to the sides of the creek to realign and maintain the overall creek channel and reduce flooding risk.

**Exempt Status:**

**Reasons why project is exempt:** **Class 1** because is the project consists of the maintenance of an existing stream (topographical feature) involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use for an existing and ongoing project. **Class 4** because the project consists of minor private alterations in the condition of land which do not involve the removal of any healthy, mature, scenic trees.
