Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to immediately repair damages due to heavy rains which caused asphalt concrete (AC) pavement to fail. The pavement failure is located on Interstate 5 (I-5) in Stanislaus County, on both northbound and southbound truck lanes from Merced/Stanislaus County Line at postmile 0.0, to I-5 and State Route 580 (SR-580) interchange at postmile 27.0. Pavement failure also occurred on SR-33 in Stanislaus County on both northbound and southbound lanes from Stuhr Road, postmile 2.0, to Ward Road, postmile 14.5. The scope of work includes removing the localized failed AC pavement and replacing with HMA-A. The purpose of this project is to repair the failed State Routes. The project is needed to
