The proposed project would involve demolition of an existing surface parking lot and construction of 16 townhomes in four separate two and three-story buildings on a 0.81-acre site. Two of the 16 units would be below market rate and would be designated as affordable housing; .4 units would be paid in-lieu. The project will also include a subdivision map to allow for a single lot, 16-unit condominium subdivision. The project utilizes concessions and waivers in accordance with State Density Bonus Law.


