Project Title: Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard Reclaimed Water Line Replacement

Project Location(s): Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard bridge over Pleasant Grove Creek, approximately ½ mile north of Blue Oaks Boulevard. Assessor's Parcel Numbers 017-117-ROW-000 and 482-130-011-000.

<u>Project Description</u>: The project would replace a portion of an existing 30-inch reclaimed water line that currently crosses under Pleasant Grove creek parallel to the adjacent Woodcreek Oaks Boulevard Creek that spans the creek with a maximum 15-inch pipeline that will be attached to the bridge. The underground pipeline would be abandoned and capped in compliance with all applicable regulations. The replacement pipeline would serve the same purpose at the existing pipeline. The capacity of the line would decrease, as it was determined that the existing pipeline is oversized. Because the replacement pipeline would be attached to the bridge, rather than replaced under the creek, impacts to sensitive riparian habitat would be avoided.

Public Agency Approving Project: Roseville City Council

<u>Agency/Individual Carrying Out Project</u>: City of Roseville Environmental Utilities Department

Reason why this Project is Exempt: The project qualifies for a Class 2 Categorical Exemption as described in Section 15302 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines which states:

"Class 2 consists of the... replacement... of existing... facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaces and will have substantially the same size, purpose, and capacity as the structure replaced, including but not limited to: ...replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity."

The project consists of replacement and abandonment of an existing reclaimed water pipeline and would not result in expansion of use. The replacement pipeline would be located within the same site as the pipeline being replaced and would have the same purpose. Therefore, the Class 2 Categorical Exemption applies.
