## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Overall project goals are to 1.) improve forest health and resilience to severe wildfire, drought, disease, and pests, 2.) reduce wildfire risk for nearby communities and infrastructure, 3) facilitate fire suppression operations, 4) increase long-term carbon capture and storage to ensure treated and adjacent forested areas remain net sinks of carbon and continue to provide an abundance of ecosystem and societal benefits.

The project area consists of mixed conifer stands, plantations composed of ponderosa pine and Douglas-fir ranging from 3 to 32 years old and isolated brush patches and rock outcroppings. The native mixed conifer stands are composed of ponderosa pine, sugar pine, white fir, Douglas-fir, and incense cedar. Elevations range from 3,600 to 6,000 feet with side slopes of 0-60%.

CalFire will provide funding to Siskiyou County and partners to assist the US Forest Service to underburn stands that were previously treated by mechanical means to reduce fire damage and create fuel breaks along a major ridge system on the north end of Scott Valley. The project will enhance the existing treatments and complete the planned work by reducing the surface fuels.
