

## **NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

DATE: January 3, 2024

Based upon the conclusions set forth in the Initial Study, the CEQA Lead Agency finds that the proposed Project, which includes measures and mitigations designed to minimize environmental impacts, would not result in significant adverse effects on the environment. The CEQA Lead Agency has prepared this Notice of Intent to adopt the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration pursuant to 14 CCR Section 15072.

**Title:** DON PEDRO RECREATION AGENCY VISITOR CENTER PROJECT

**Project Description:** Turlock Irrigation District (TID) proposes to construct a new building, functioning primarily as a staff administration office and customer visitor center, and rehabilitate the existing Trading Post. These two buildings will operate together and provide services and infrastructure to support DPRA staff needs, visitor's needs, as well as customer needs for special events.

**Project Location:** The proposed Project site is approximately one (1) mile east of the DPRA Headquarters and within the Fleming Meadows Campground in Tuolumne County.

**Project Proponent:** Don Pedro Recreation Agency

**Lead Agency:** TID

**Public Review Period:** A 30-day public review period will begin on January 3, 2024. Written comments must be submitted to the Lead Agency no later than 5:00 PM on February 2, 2024.
