Section 15303. The exemption includes but is not limited to: (d) allowing for reasonable water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, to serve such construction. The project involves the installation of two new streetlights in an already developed area. The new streetlights will be powered by the existing subsurface utilities.
