Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YOL-29753-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Department of Water Resources (DWR).
