
NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND INITIAL STUDY

DATE: January 12, 2024

TO: Responsible Agencies, Interested Parties, and Organizations

SUBJECT: **Mendota Wildlife Area Solar Project — MENDOTA, FRESNO COUNTY, CA**

The California Department of General Services (DGS) is the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Lead Agency for the proposed Mendota Wildlife Area Solar Project (Proposed Project). DGS has directed the preparation of an Initial Study (IS) Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) in compliance with CEQA.

Project Location: The Proposed Project is located at 4333 Santa Fe Grade, in Mendota, Fresno County, California within the Mendota Wildlife Area, which is owned and operated by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW).

Project Description: The California Department of General Services (DGS) Mendota Wildlife Area Solar Project (Proposed Project) is a solar Photovoltaic (PV) power generation system that would include 504 ground-mounted solar arrays that would occupy 28,000 square-feet. The Proposed Project will convert sunlight to Direct Current (DC) electrical power which would then be converted to Alternating Current (AC) by string inverters before being delivered to the PG&E distribution system. The total system is expected to be approximately 219 kilowatts. The Proposed Project would support energy reduction goals, the Global Warming Solutions Act, and Governor's Green Building Order S-20-04.

Potentially Significant Environmental Impacts: Potentially significant impacts to air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, paleontological resources, and geology and soils were identified in the Initial Study. All impacts would be reduced to a less than significant level with the implementation of identified mitigation measures.

Hazardous Waste Sites: Pursuant to Section 15087(c)(6) of the Guidelines for California Environmental Quality Act, DGS acknowledges the non-existence of hazardous waste sites within the Project area reviewed by this Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND).

IS/MND Document Review and Availability: The public review and comment period for the Draft IS/MND will extend for 30 days **starting January 12, 2024 and ending February 12, 2024**.
