#### Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

Tehama County Public Works (County) is proposing to re-armor the Antelope Creek Bridge upstream and underneath the northern bridge abutment and along the center pier. The previously grouted rock slope protection was undermined and collapsed during last winter's storms. The County will use the minimum effective amount of rock slope protection (RSP) necessary to prevent further erosion and potential bridge failure in the upcoming winter season. Temporary impacts will include access to place the RSP.

Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination.

## Reasons why Project is Exempt:

This project is Categorically Exempt under CEQA section 15301 because the project involves minor repair of existing facilities with no expansion of use.
