4 (W11-3 Deer) warning signs with flashing beacons will be installed and one previously installed warning sign at Postmile (PM) 1.27 will be modified to replace the W16-4P Plaque (Next 7 Miles) and install flashing beacons. The deer sign at PM14.50 (Location 2) will be removed and replaced to PM 14.60. All 4 locations will receive flashing beacons. All four flashing beacons will be solar power.

Location 1: Postmile (PM) 1.27 (Electrical pole)

Location 2: Postmile (PM) 14.60 (Electrical pole)

Location 3: Postmile (PM) R8.04 (Electrical pole)

Location 4: Postmile (PM) R8.60 (Electrical pole)

Staging

The project does not anticipate staging outside of Caltrans right of way. If additional staging is required, the area will be cleared by the Contractor and Caltrans environmental staff.
