Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Project proposes to restore meadow floodplain function in the Butte Creek House meadow. Restoration activities will include application of process- and form-based techniques to reconnect the stream to the floodplain, aggrade incised channels, activate secondary flow paths, and arrest headcut features. The Project will implement postassisted log structures, beaver dam analogs, strategically placed felled logs, headcut treatment, channel fill, riffle augmentation, selective removal of lodgepole pine, and planting of riparian shrubs. Habitat restoration will benefit common and sensitive species that inhabit aquatic, riparian, and wet meadow habitats, including native amphibians, cold water fish, aquatic macroinvertebrates, and other riparian and meadow plant species.
