PROJECT TITLE: Museum Generator Installation

LOCATION: Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park COUNTY: Amador

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a 48KW propane generator at Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park, on the north side of the museum, ensure the museum has a reliable source of power to continue park operations and protect museum artifacts and archives in the event of an emergency or during public safety shutoffs. Work will:

- Approx. 2 feet from the building, use a small skid steer to excavate a 4-foot wide by 6-foot long area to level:
- Pour a 4-foot wide x 6-foot long concrete pad;
- Install the generator and use concrete anchors to secure it to the concrete pad;
- Install conduit along the museum's exterior wall to the furnace room which houses the main electrical service;
- Install a transfer switch in the furnace room or on the exterior of the museum near the furnace room;
- Excavate a 24-inch deep x 18-inch wide trench from the generator to the existing museum propane supply line; and
- Connect the generator to the existing propane tank.
