Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

Liza Creek experienced significant bank scour which has eroded out a section of Reeds Creek Road. The proposed project will reconstruct a portion of the eroded bank and protect it with rock slope protection placed above the ordinary high water mark to prevent future scour and damage to the roadway.

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has determined that the Project is exempt from review under CEQA pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, Article 19, section 15301, Existing Facilities. Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use.
