#### Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

Union Pacific Railroad inspections have identified defects indicating that routine maintenance can no longer extend the safe operational condition of Bridge 458.78. The project will replace the existing 87-foot-long Segment B with proposed 93-foot-5-inchlong Segment B in the same alignment. Proposed Segment B will consist of three prestressed concrete box (PCB) girder spans, consisting of one 34-foot, one 30-foot, and one 29-foot-5-inch PCB. The replacement structure will have a total length of 93 feet 5 inches.

#### Exempt Status:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from review under CEQA pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Article 19, section 15302, Replacement or Reconstruction. Class 2 consists of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.
