ROAD DISTRICT 4 STREETS RESURFACING 2024 Project Description

Project Location:

Beecher Road: Fairchild Lane to Comstock Road; **Confer Road:** Fairchild Lane to Baker Road; **Ferguson Road:** Baker Road to Comstock Road. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

Beecher Road previously known as Rhoden Road is a two-lane 22-foot wide roadway first constructed in 1931 as a 16' wide road with 1" oiled top course over 5" of base. All other construction info is unknown. **Confer Road** previously known as Ferguson Road is a two-lane 22-foot wide roadway of unknown construction. **Ferguson Road** is a two-lane 22-foot wide roadway of unknown construction. All 3 roadways have been maintained with periodic chips seals with the last application occurring in 2015.

Existing pavement exhibits transverse, longitudinal, block, and alligator cracking throughout the project limits.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

- 1. Resurfacing existing roadway on Beecher Road with 0.25' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A), and 0.17' HMA (Type A) on Confer Road and Ferguson Road.
- 2. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.25' to 0.50' HMA (Type A).
- 3. Replenishing 4' wide shoulder backing: 2' (8% slope) and 2' to conform.
- 4. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' or to conform.
- 5. Adjusting existing monument frames and covers to finish grade.
- 6. Constructing 4-8' HMA (Type A) driveways and frontages.


Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily rural with single family homes.

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
