7. **DESCRIPTION:** The purpose of this geotechnical investigation is to sample soils within the project area (APNs: 147-074-15,147-074-14, and 147-263-24) in order to inform preliminary design and address permitting requirements for the Pier View Way Bridge & Lifeguard Headquarters and Beachfront Improvement Phase II Projects. The investigation will utilize rotary wash and cone penetration borings. See attached area map for locations and additional information.

**ADMINISTRATIVE DETERMINATION:** Planning Division staff has completed a preliminary review of this project in accordance with the City of Oceanside's Environmental Review Guidelines and the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), 1970.
