Commercial Cannabis Use Permit (CCUP) for the construction and operation of a cannabis cultivation, harvest, processing, and storage facility on a 47.7-acre parcel. The project would consist of approximately 87,120 square feet (sf) of full-time outdoor cannabis cultivation area, a 240-sf modular office, a solar power system, and eight 320-sf shipping containers. Processing would seasonally occur within a temporary tent which would be located within the cultivation area. The cannabis cultivation area would include approximately 1.28 acres of hoop houses located on the east portion of the project area. The applicant would access power using a combination of solar power, a backup generator which would be located within a 120-sf tough shed, and a connection with existing Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) infrastructure. The solar panel array would be located west of the cultivation area.
