PROJECT TITLE: Russian Gulch Waterline – Geotech Investigation

LOCATION: Russian Gulch State Park

COUNTY: Mendocino

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Conduct geotechnical investigations at Russian Gulch State Park to identify soil conditions underneath existing asphalt and gravel roads to allow for installation of new water and sewer lines. Work will use a truck-mounted drill, equipped with hollow-stem augers and/or mud rotary drilling equipment to drill up to six (6) exploratory borings in the vicinity of existing roads, ranging from 10-ft to 37-ft in depth. Representative soil samples will be recorded for future analysis and the borings will be back-filled with excavated materials with excess drill cuttings spread onsite.
