Project Title: King Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-43842-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Strongs Creek watershed, in the City of Fortuna, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 11, T2N, R1W, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Fortuna U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor’s Parcel Number 202-131-061; latitude 40.57560 N and longitude 124.14690 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to one encroachment to install a stream crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, installation of a new minimum 24-inch diameter culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
