Statement of reasons why project is exempt: The proposed action complies with CEQA because it is subject to the common sense exemption, because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that it may have a significant effect on the environment (Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines) because acceptance of these grant funds has no potential to cause a physical change in the environment. The proposed action seeks the authority for the application and acceptance of grant funding for the enhancement of the licensing program and compliance activities for both licensed and unlicensed activities. The program enhancements consist of increased staffing, equipment, IT Improvements, and training in support existing licensing and enforcement activities. The enhancements resulting from the proposed action are administrative in nature with the action exempt from CEQA review because it can be seen with certainty that the activity will not have a significant effect on the environment. Any future projects that may develop as a result of this action would require CEQA compliance prior to implementation. None of the exceptions to the exemptions apply (Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines) because the ordinance does not authorize, ban or exempt any development and therefore will not cause impacts to scenic highways, hazardous waste sites or historical resources. In addition, see Attachment A, A Resolution of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors authorizing Director, Planning & Development Services, to apply for and accept funds from the California Board of State and Community Corrections Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program, dated January 24, 2024, attached to this form.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING DIRECTOR, PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT SERVICES, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PROPOSITION 64 PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM (DISTRICTS: ALL)

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego desires to participate in the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program funded through the California State and Local Government Law Enforcement Account and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as the BSCC).

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2022 (21), the Board of Supervisors directed the Chief Administrative Officer to explore the establishment of a cannabis licensing program to be managed by Code Compliance rather than managed by law enforcement and return to the Board with options for the Cannabis Facility Operation Certificate Fee.

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2022 (6), the Board of Supervisors authorized the transfer of the cannabis licensing program to PDS and approved the introduction of an ordinance amending the County Administrative and Regulatory Codes to include licensing fees, include PDS in the uniform licensing procedure, and remove the Sheriff's Department from cannabis licensing regulations.

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2022 (1), the Board of Supervisors took action on Consent, adopting Ordinance No. 10812 (N.S.) entitled: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUSINESS REGULATIONS, TITLE 2, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE TO ADD PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO THE UNIFORM LICENSING PROCEDURE AND REMOVE THE SHIERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FROM THE CANNABIS LICENSING REGULATIONS DATED OCOTBER 26, 2022 ORDINANCE; AND, Ordinance No. 10813 (N.S.), entitled: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XX, SECTION 362.1, OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO INCLUDE CANNABIS FACILITY OPERAITONS LICENSING FEES.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Director of Planning & Development Services and/or designee be authorized on behalf of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County of San Diego agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.

The Clerk of the Board of the County of San Diego shall certify as to the adoption of this Resolution.
