**PROJECT DESCRIPTION & LOCATION:** The project is a request to subdivide three parcels totaling 52.42 acres into 40 one-acre residential lots. The project site is located near the northwest corner of North Leeds Road and East Olive Avenue, identified as Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 238-020-007, 238-020-001, and 108-070-005. The project site is designated Merced Rural Residential Center - Agricultural-Residential land use and zoned R-R (Rural Residential).
