Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The City of Newport Beach owns and operates the Transfer Station located 592 Superior Ave, Newport Beach CA pursuant to a Solid Waste Facility Permit issued by the County of Orange Health Care Agency, Environmental Health, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency. Pursuant to the existing permit, storage capacity of the facility was defined at 180 tons per day and the Permitted Maximum Tonnage is limited to 300 tons per day. The City of Newport Beach requests to amend the existing permit to include disposal of street sweeping debris and green waste material.

Reasons why project is exempt: Class 1 (Existing Facilities) consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alterations of existing public and private structures involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. In this case, the change in permitting to allow disposal of street sweeping debris and green waste material does not change the storage capacity of the existing facility or exceed the permitted maximum tonnage authorized under the existing permit. Maximum permitted tonnage is 300 tons per day; the averages 94.35 tons per day, which includes the 10.9 tons from street sweeping and 0.77 tons of green waste.
