In this case, the change in permitting to allow disposal of street sweeping debris and green waste material does not change the storage capacity of the existing facility or exceed the permitted maximum tonnage authorized under the existing permit. Maximum permitted tonnage is 300 tons per day; the averages 94.35 tons per day, which includes the 10.9 tons from street sweeping and 0.77 tons of green waste.
