Project Description:

The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a cannabis retailer license submitted on 3/22/2020 by NorthStar Marysville.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of a retail cannabis store located within an existing 70,000 square foot building. The dispensary activities will be occurring in approximately 2,000 square feet of the ground floor of the building.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is a Class 32 Categorical Exemption project. Class 32 Categorical Exemptions consist of projects consistent with the applicable general plan designation and all applicable general plan policies as well as with applicable zoning designation and regulations. The proposed development occurs within city limits on a project site of no more than five acres substantially surrounded by urban uses. The project site has no value, as habitat for endangered, rare or threatened species. Approval of the project would not result in any significant effects relating to traffic, noise, air quality, or water quality. The site can be adequately served by all required utilities and public services. The project fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15332, and none of the exceptions to this exemption defined in Section 15300.2 apply.
