Project Title: Middle Mile Broadband Network Project 29 (Project), Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-KER-36761-R4 (SAA)

Project Location: The Project will occur within multiple unnamed ephemeral streams along State Route 58, approximately 5 miles west of the community of Boron, between Post Mile R138.0 and Post Mile R121.6, in eastern Kern County.

Project Description: On 2/2/2024, CDFW executed the SAA pursuant to Fish and Game Code 1600 et seq., and the Project authorized by the SAA will be carried out by the California Department of Technology. The Project involves activities related to installation of the state-owned Middle Mile Broadband Network across streams including site preparation (clearing and grubbing), trenching, plowing, and backfilling of excavated areas. The SAA includes conditions governing authorized activities such as necessary reasonable measures to avoid, minimize, and mitigate impacts to fish and wildlife resources.


