Excavation is estimated to be 12-inches wide and an average of 4-feet deep. The total work area is assumed to be 25-feet wide.

## Reasons why project is exempt:

Section 15303(d) New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures (Class 3): The Class 3 Categorical Exemption consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures. Example (d) includes water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, of reasonable length to serve such construction. The project involves the installation of 652-feet of new 2-inch gas service line.

Section 15304 Minor Alterations to Land (Class 4): The Class 4 Categorical Exemption consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. Examples include, but are not limited to: (f) trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored. The project involves Installation of 652-feet of new 2-inch gas service line via open trench excavation method. Excavation is estimated to be 12 inches wide and an average of 4 feet deep. Upon completion the trench will be backfilled and the surface finished to match surrounding materials.

The Port has determined that none of the exceptions to the exemptions in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15300.2 foreclose the use of the categorical exemption CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 (Small Structures), and 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); therefore the Project is exempt from CEQA and no further environmental review is required.
