The proposed project would include demolition of one (1) relocatable building and five (5) buildings including the Administration Building A, Gymnasium Building D, the Cafeteria Building E, Auditorium Building C, and Classroom (Science/Shop) Building B. Three (3) New permanent buildings will be constructed: a two-to-three-story, 102,000 sq. ft. classroom/administration/cafeteria building, a partial two-story 34,000 sq. ft. gymnasium/ locker room/classroom/library building, and a one-story 14,000 sq. ft. auditorium.
