Box 751 41000 Main Street Riverside, CA 92501-0751 Temecula, CA 92590 **Project Title:** Long Range Application No. LR24-0068, (PW23-02) Ynez Road Improvements - Phase I **Description of Project:** The project consists of widening the easterly side of Ynez Road, from Tierra Vista to Rancho Vista Road from a single lane to two lanes. With this, a retaining wall will be constructed and related shoulder work complete for installation/improvement of an inlet adjacent to a small grove of oak trees. **Project Location:** Ynez Road, from Tierra Vista to Rancho Vista Road **Applicant/Proponent:** City of Temecula The Assistant Director of Community Development approved the above described project on February 8, 2024 and found that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act, as amended. Exempt Status: (check one) Ministerial (Section 21080(b)(1); Section 15268); Statutory Exemptions (Section Number: Declared Emergency (Section 21080(b)(3); Section Categorical Exemption; (Section Number 15304 & 15269(a)); 15303) Emergency Project (Section 21080(b)(4); Section Other: Section 15162 Categorical Exemption 15269(b)(c)); Statement of Reasons Supporting the Finding that the Project is Exempt: The project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under Sections 15304 and 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines. The road widening is within the scope of the Class 4 categorical exemption for "minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water and/or vegetation which do not involve the removal of healthy, mature scenic trees..." The project requires the removal of 3 heritage-sized trees but according to the arborist report, they are only in "fair" health with "fair" form/structure, and the City has determined they are not healthy, mature, and scenic. A retaining wall that is part of the project also qualifies for the Class 3 categorial exemption applicable to the construction of new, small structures.
