PROJECT TITLE: Montara State Beach: Gate and Fencing Repair/Installation

LOCATION: Montara State Beach

COUNTY: Santa Mateo

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project consists of replacing a storm damaged chain link fence Montara Dirt lot at Montara State Beach, with a new wooden fence in a slightly altered alignment and with an added swing gate where the emergency access lane meets Highway. Work will:

- Excavate up to thirty-six (36) 12-in. x 12-in. post holes;
- Install up to thirty-six (36) wooden posts and backfill around the posts with excavated soils to secure;
- Attach seventy-two (72) wooden rails to the posts;
- Excavate two (2) 2-ft x 2-ft post holes and install one (1) 4ft x 12ft metal gate; and
- Backfill around gate posts with excavated soils to secure.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the operation, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced; construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, included as "Construction or installation of park facilities such as fencing and gates" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR §15300.4; and minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes.
