**Project Title:** Olive Spring Quarry, Inc. Mining Permit and Expansion (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0134-R3)

**Project Location:** The project is located at East Branch Soquel Creek a tributary to Soquel Creek, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37.06032, Longitude -121.92495 or Section 13, Township 10S, Range 1W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Laurel or 1703 Olive Springs Road Soquel, CA 95073; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 099-261-01 and 099-251-01.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0134-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the CHY Company.

The proposed project will draft water from East Branch Soquel Creek to support operations of the Olive Springs Quarry and timberland management. The proposed project is limited to the diversion of water from Soquel Creek and the placement of a non-permanent portable pump attached to a 3-inched water inlet pipe.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 01/09/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project  will /  will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
