The Project consists of improvements to approximately 2.4 miles of Mullholland Highway, including widening the road shoulder, realigning the roadway centerline as needed to provide wider shoulders, slope grading to prevent erosion, slope stabilization improvements, a retaining wall and intersection improvements. All improvements would be located within the public right-of-way along Mulholland Highway or within existing slope easements, except new or expanded slope easements

would be required on five parcels to accommodate penetration of soil nails to be used for slope stabilization.
