Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

Construction of a new water well intended to serve as a water source for livestock grazing onsite.

Exempt Status: Categorical Exemption; Section(s): 15302 Type: Class 2 Replacement or reconstruction

Reason why project is exempt:

This project consists of replacement/reconstruction of an existing structure consisting of a water well with a proposed depth of 200' - 300', minimum screened depth of 200', and casing diameter of 5".

Exceptions for exemption detailed in Section 15300.2 do not apply for the following reasons:

- a) Location: No particularly sensitive environmental resources are known to exist at the project location.
- b) Cumulative Impact: No cumulative impacts are anticipated as successive projects of the same type in the same place are anticipated.
- c) Significant Effect: there is no known reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances.
- d) Scenic Highways. No damage to scenic resources within a state scenic highway is anticipated.
- e) Hazardous Waste Sites: the project is not located on a site known to be a hazardous waste site.
- f) Historical Resources. the project will not cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource.
