**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT**: The purpose of this project is to remove invasive, non-native plants from Benicia Capitol State Historic Park to help maintain the historic plants and landscape at the park. Licensed operators will apply herbicides with backpack sprayers to protect historic park resources. Target areas include roadsides, around park facilities, day use areas and parking areas. Signs will be posted at the entrance to the park 24 hours prior to treatments to inform the public of upcoming treatments.
