The California Highway Patrol's Marin Area has reviewed the Environmental documents submitted by Caltrans District 4 for the US-101 Corte Madera Creek Bridge Rehabilitation Project (SCH #2024020937). As is the case with any State Highway related construction project, we anticipate there will be an impact to CHP operations with response times through the construction area and due to the proposed detour.
