**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Project consists of repairing and fire hardening Residence #1 at Portola Redwoods State Park for fire resiliency and preservation of the building for future use. Work will:

- Remove failed siding and replace with in-kind siding that matches the aesthetic.
- Remove insufficient skirting and install fire resilient skirting that matches the aesthetic;
- Remove insufficient venting screens and mesh, replace with Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) approved vents and screens;
- On the south side of the house, demolish and remove existing deck, stairs, and posts;
- Install new posts and use in-kind materials to rebuild the deck and stairs, matching the existing layout, footprint and aesthetic of the removed deck;
- Remove/remediate all exterior lead paint;
- Spot prime raw wood as necessary;
- Apply two (2) coats exterior paint; and
- Remove construction debris from site.
