## Project Description

**Project Title:** San Bernardino County Flood Control District – 2024 Emergency Flood Control Facility Repairs Zones 4 & 6

**Project Location:** County-maintained dams, basins, channels, levees, berms, and culverts within the cities of Victorville and Hesperia, and in the unincorporated communities of Wrightwood, Helendale, Apple Valley, Phelan, Pinion Hills, and Yucca Valley. Refer to Exhibit A for list of damaged facilities and locations.

**Project Description:** Heavy rainfall in February 2024, resulted in significant flooding, and sediment, rock and debris deposition and scour, damaging flood control facilities, drainages, and culverts, resulting in an imminent threat to life and property. Local and State Emergency Proclamations have been issued for San Bernardino County. Emergency repair work includes, but is not limited to, removal of sediment, rock and debris for public safety purposes and repairs/replacements of damage flood control facilities and appurtenant structures.

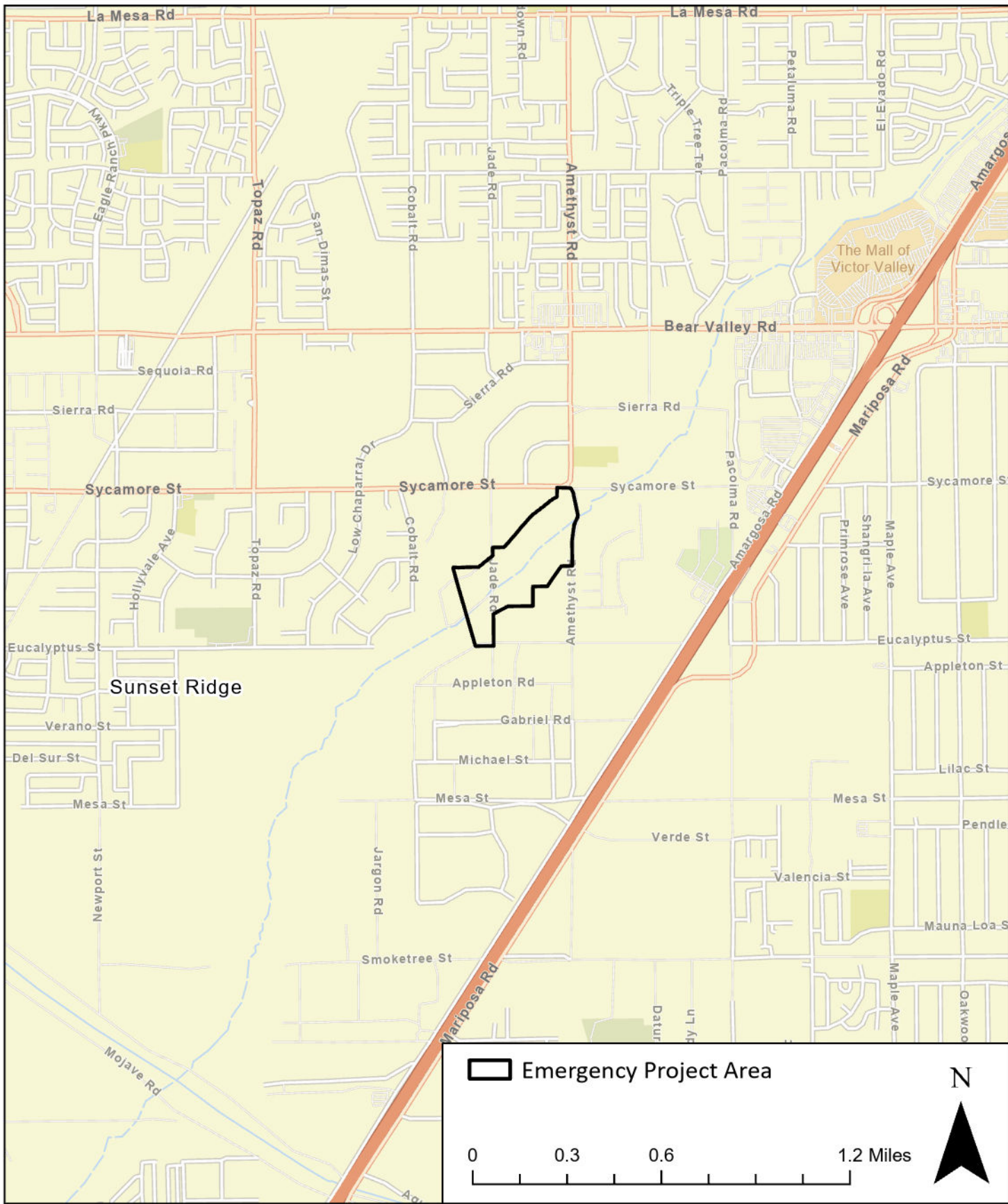

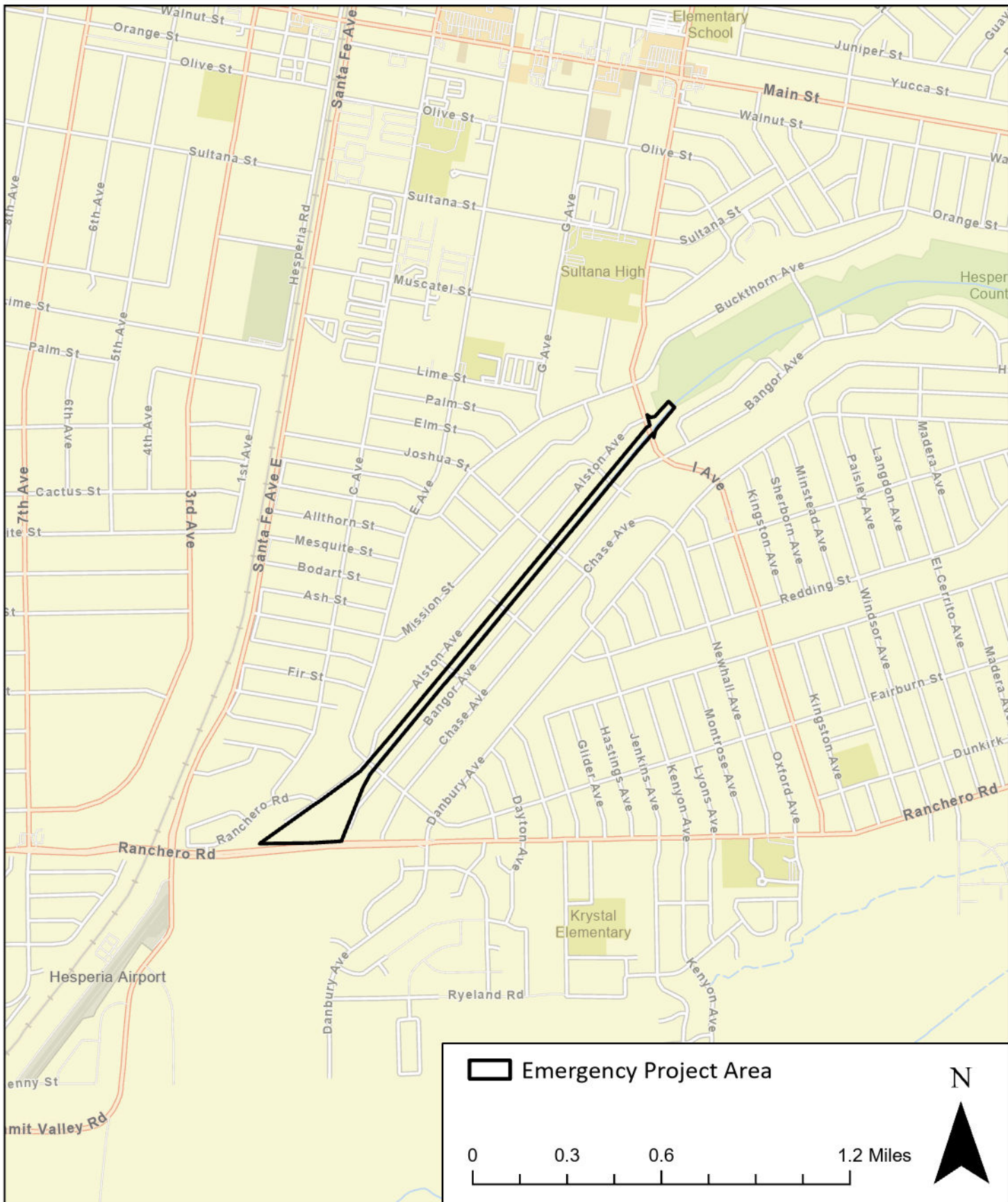

Heath Creek Channel	4-353-1A	From State Highway 2 south to Lone Pine Canyon Road and approximately 1 mile west of Lone Pine Canyon Road in the unincorporated community of Wrightwood.
Mojave River	4-101-1D, 1E, 1G, 1I	Reach 1D- Bear Valley Road south to Poppy Street and Reach 1E- Bear Valley Road north to Yucca Loma Road in the incorporated town of Apple Valley. Reach 1G- at Turner Road, west of National Trails Highway in the city of Victorville. Reach 1I- at Vista Road east of Helendale Road in the unincorporated community of Helendale.
Sheep Creek	4-354-1A, 1B, 1D	Reach 1A is south of Lone Pine Canyon Road and Reach 1B goes from Lone Pine Canyon Road to State Highway 2 in the unincorporated community of Wrightwood. Church Street Channel	6-486-1A	Between Cibola Trail and Church Street, north of Onaga Trail and south of 29 Palms Highway in the unincorporated town of Yucca Valley.
Hospital Channel	6-458-1A	Between Palm Avenue and Sage Avenue, north of Onaga Trail and south of 29 Palms Highway in the unincorporated town of Yucca Valley.
Old Woman Springs Basin	6-454-4A	Located at the intersection of Old Woman Springs Road and Paxton Road, north of 29 Palms Highway in the unincorporated town of Yucca Valley.
Yucca Creek	6-451-1A, 1B, 1C	Reach 1A travels northeast from Bannock Trail to 29 Palms Highway. Reach 1B travels northeast from 29 Palms Highway to Old Woman Springs Road. Reach 1C travels northeast from Old Woman Springs Road to Coyote Creek found east of Yucca Mesa Road and north of 29 Palms Highway in the unincorporated town of Yucca Valley.

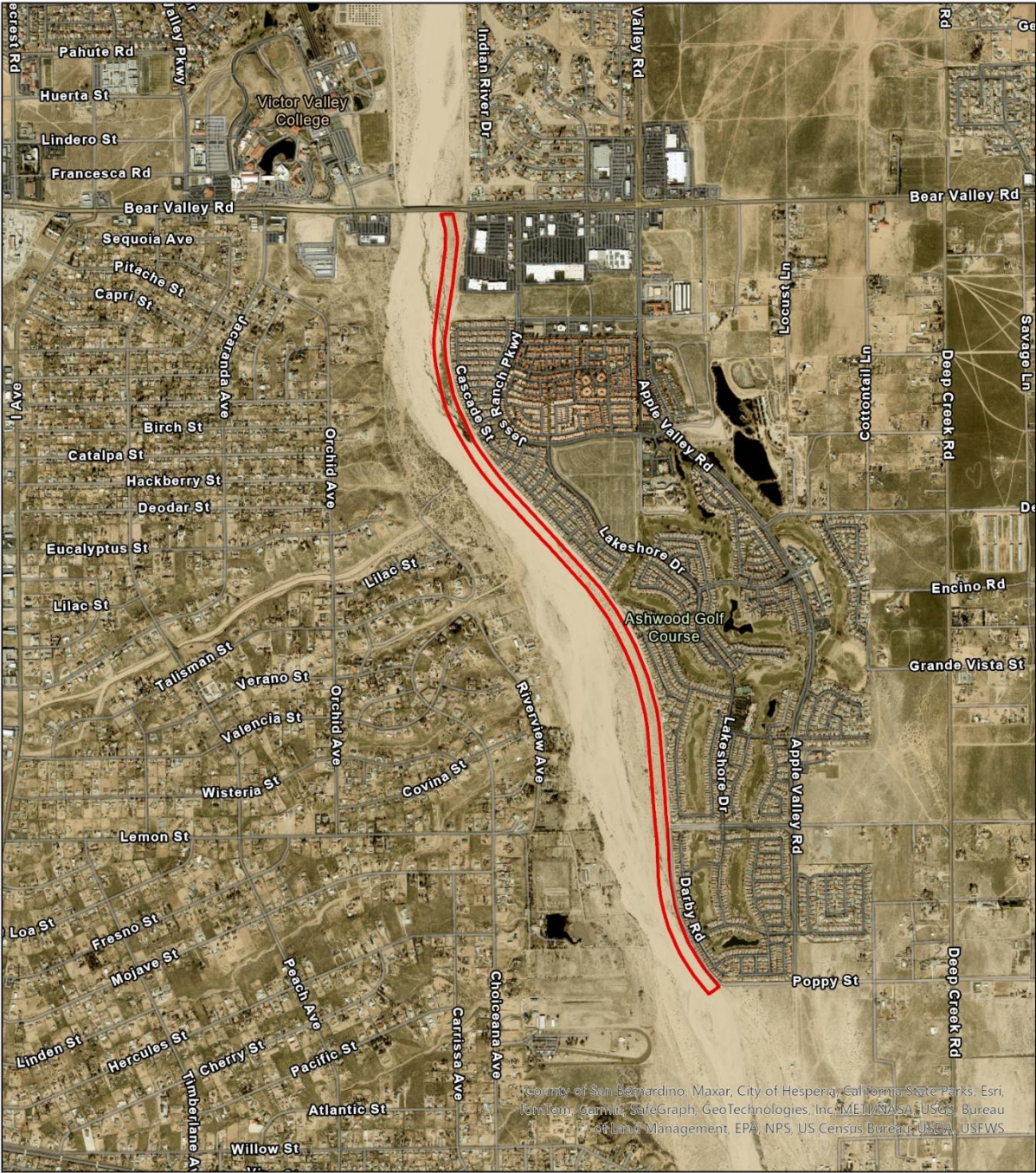


# Amethyst Basin Emergency February 2024



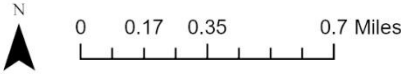

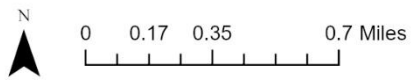
Mojave River Upstream of Bear Valley Road

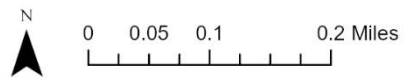
Mojave River Downstream of Bear Valley Road

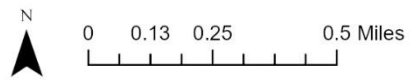

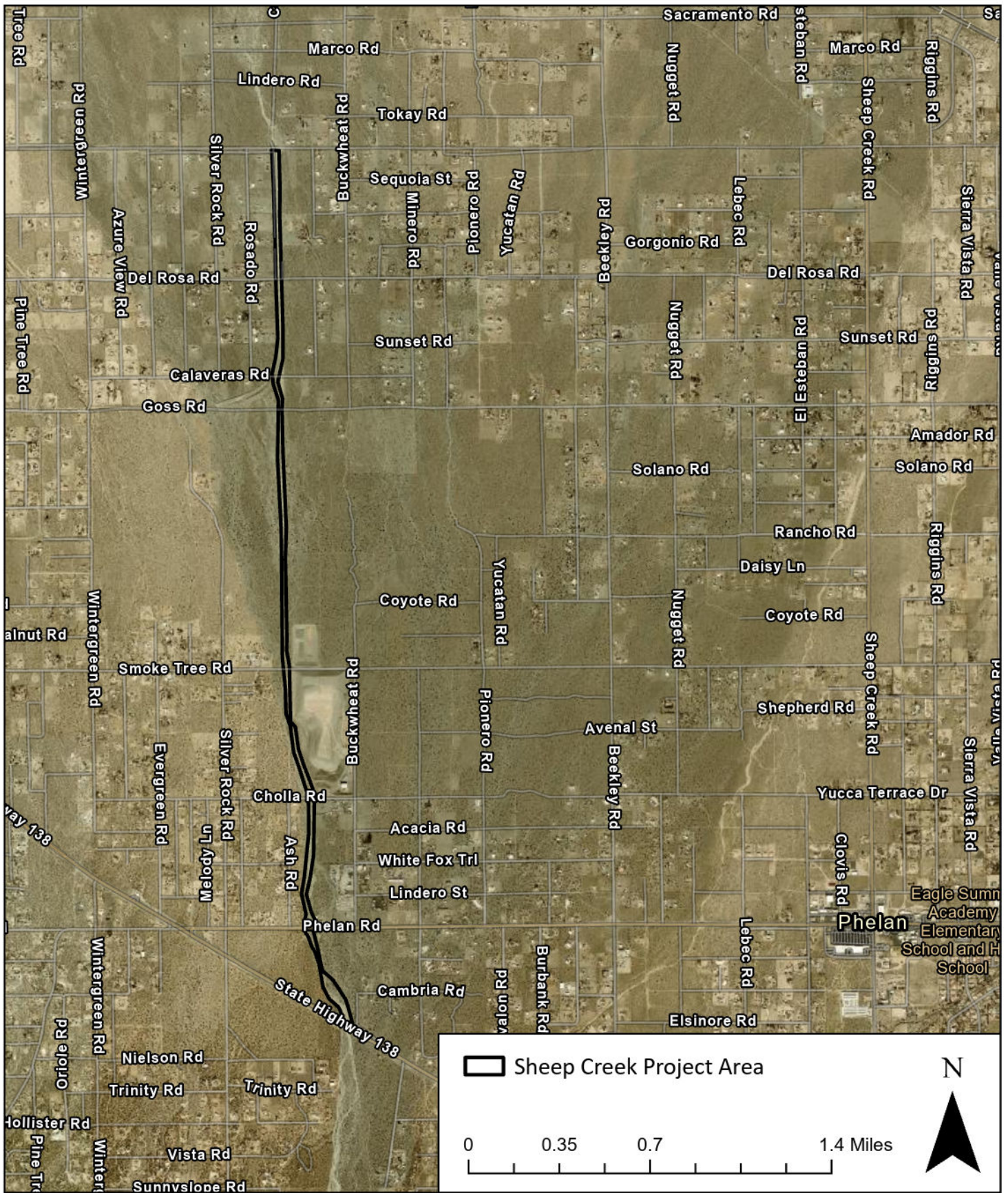

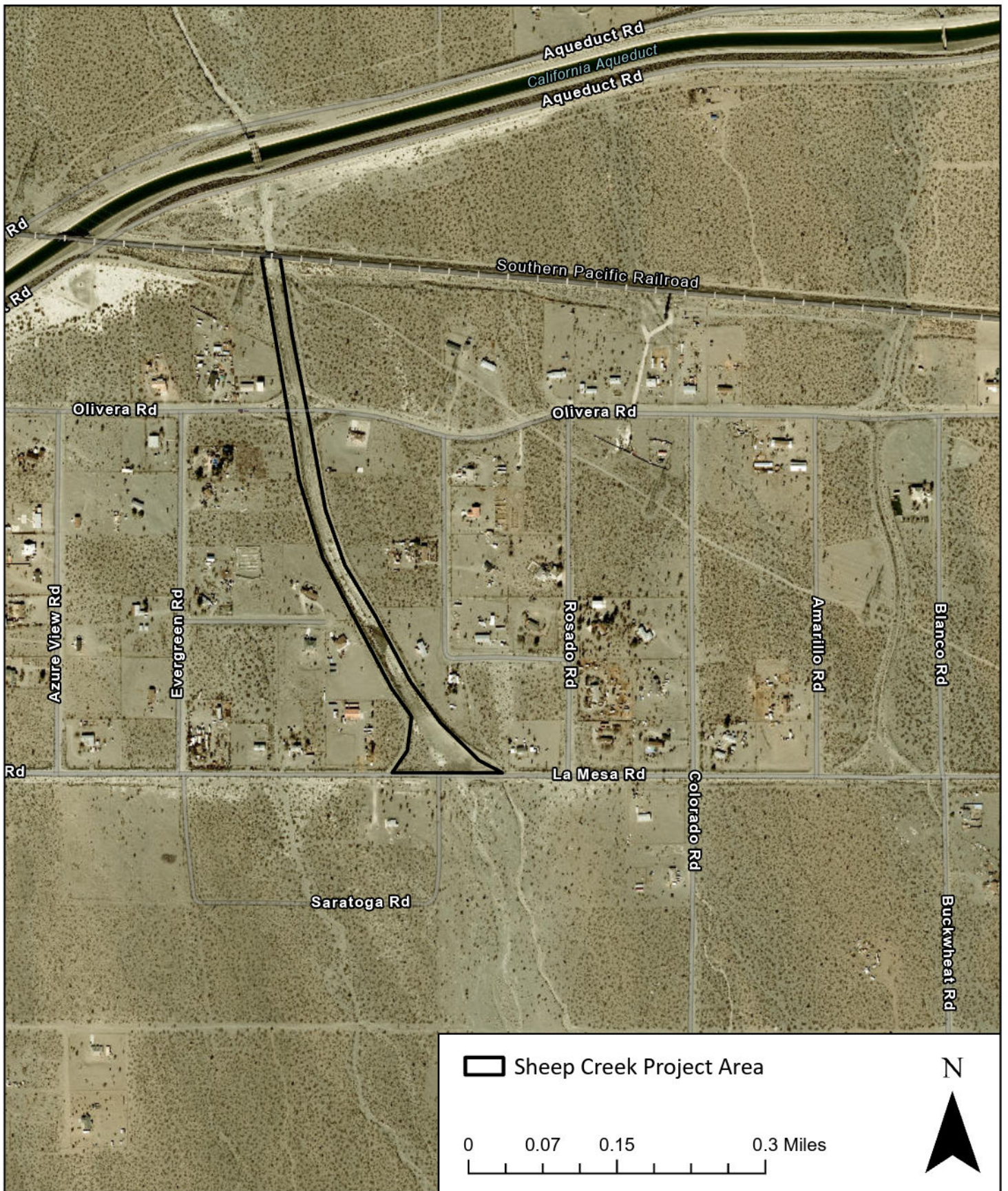

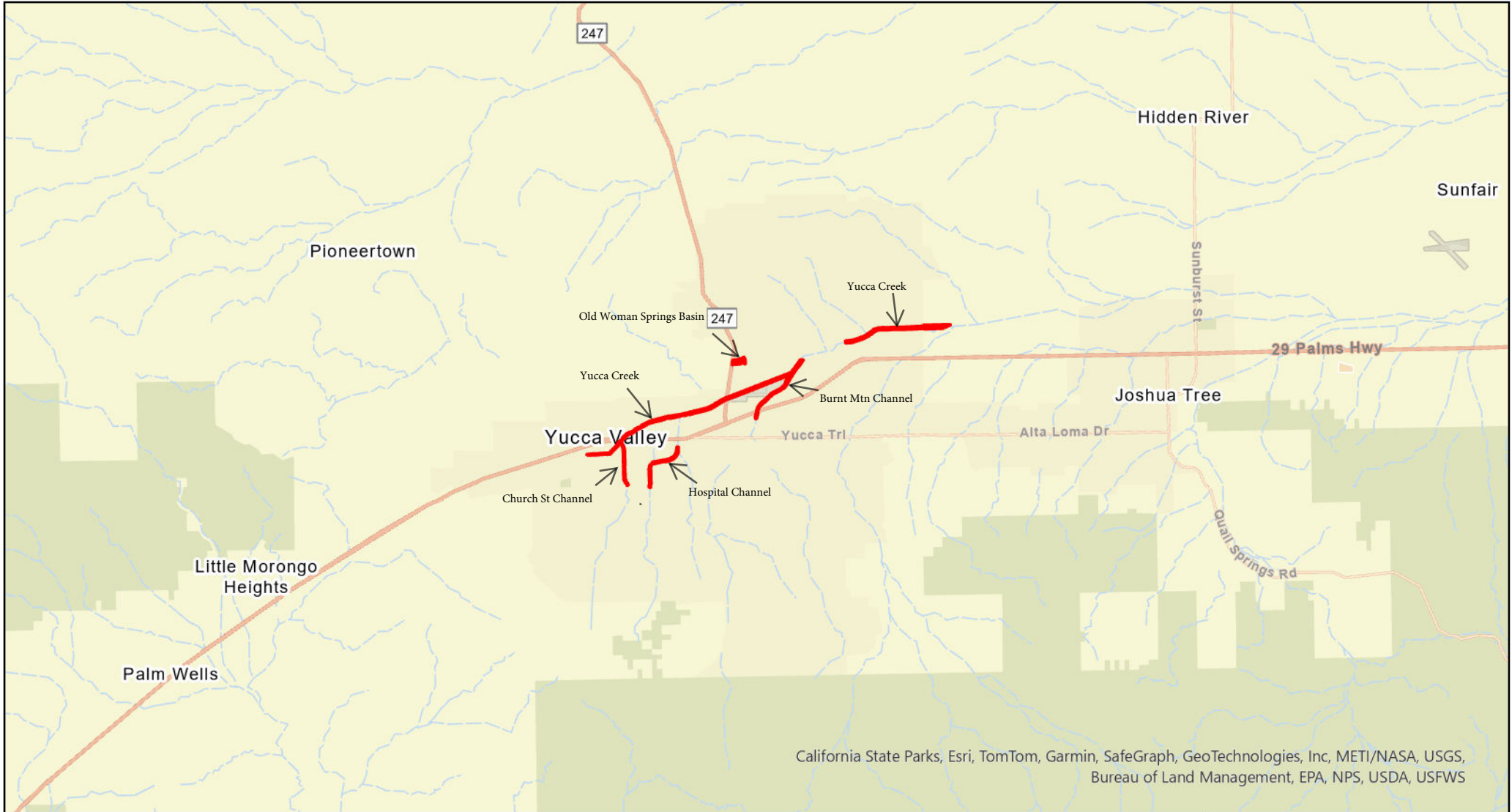

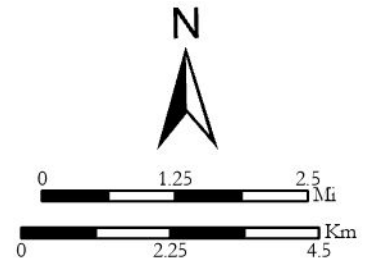

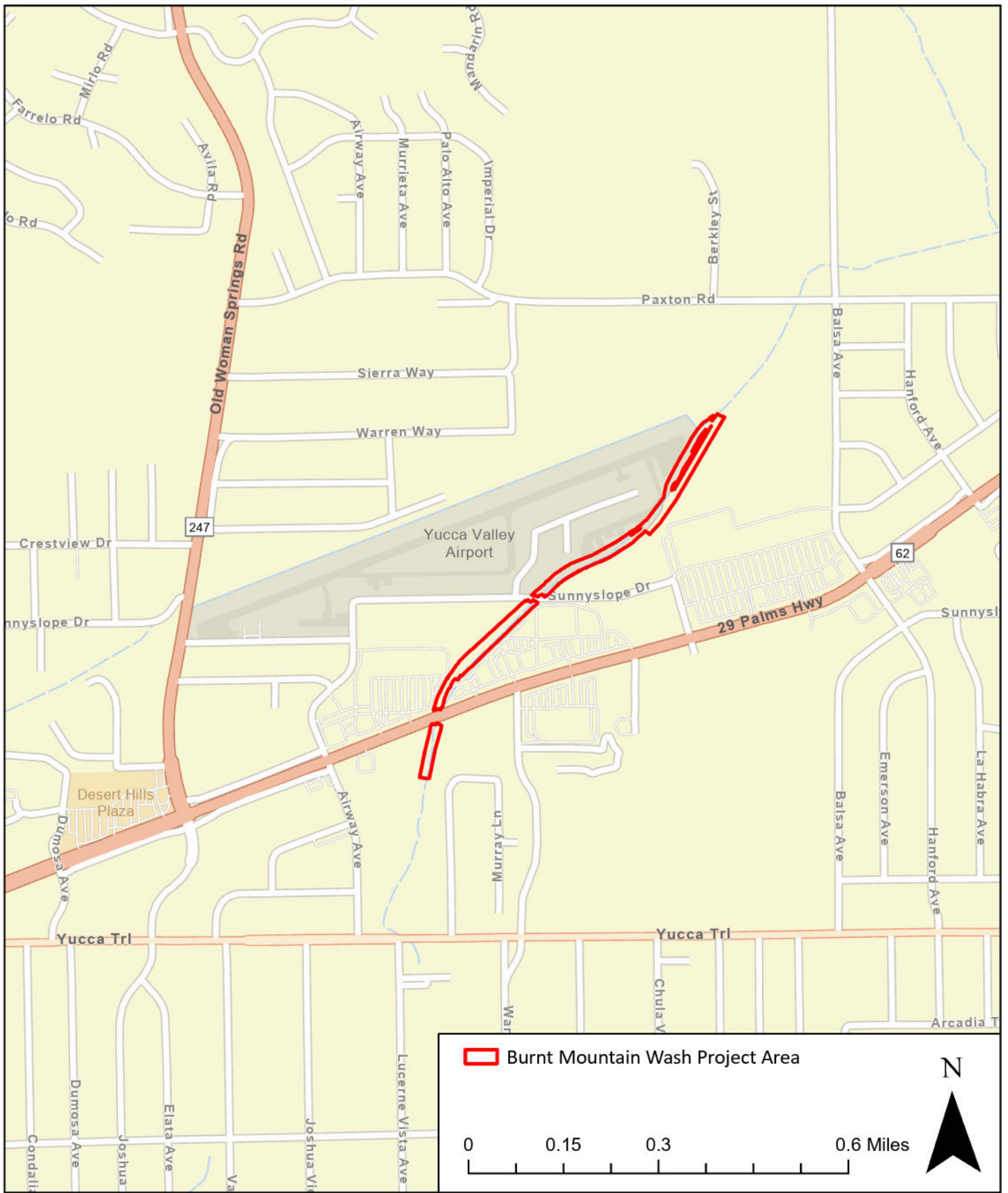

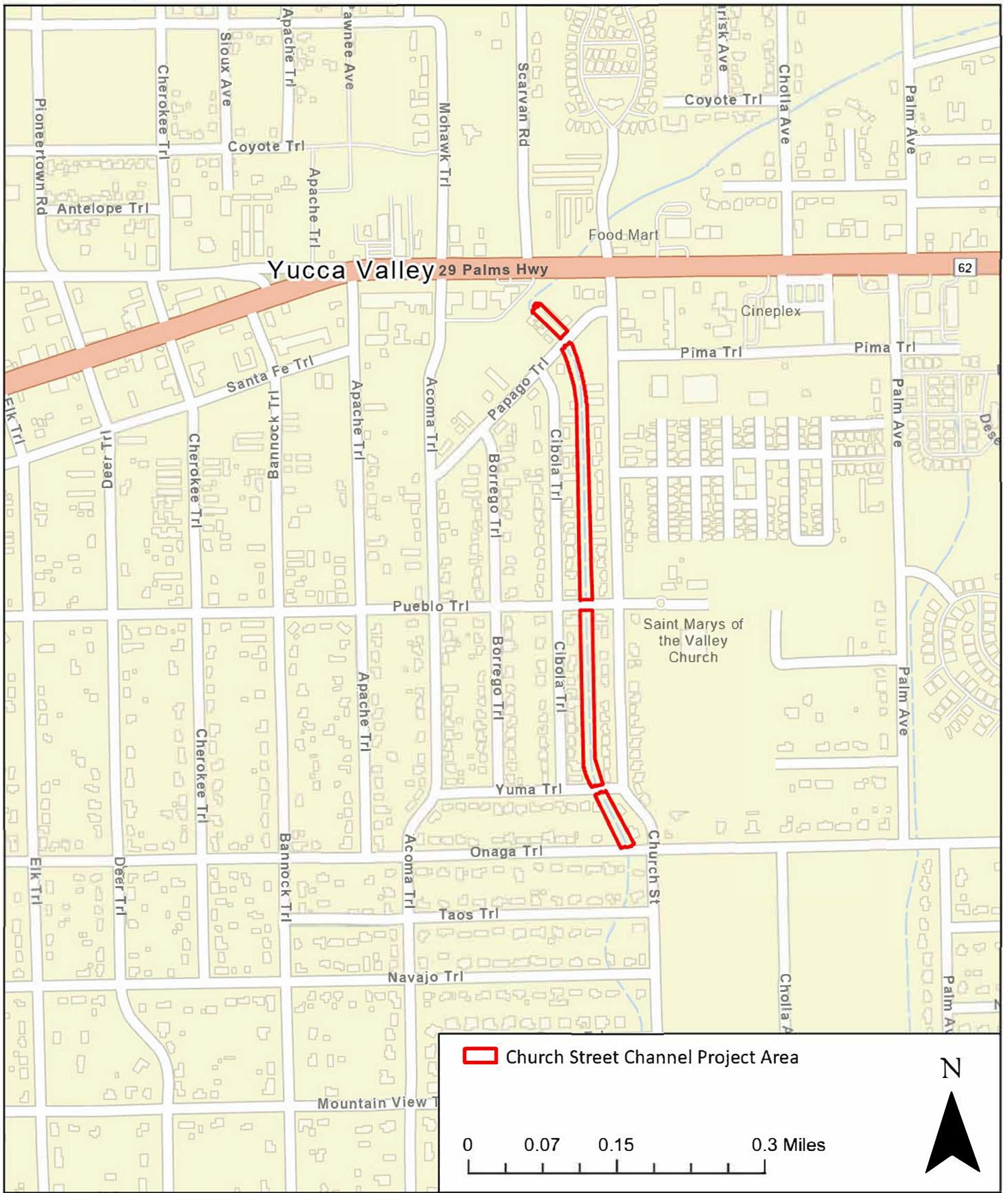

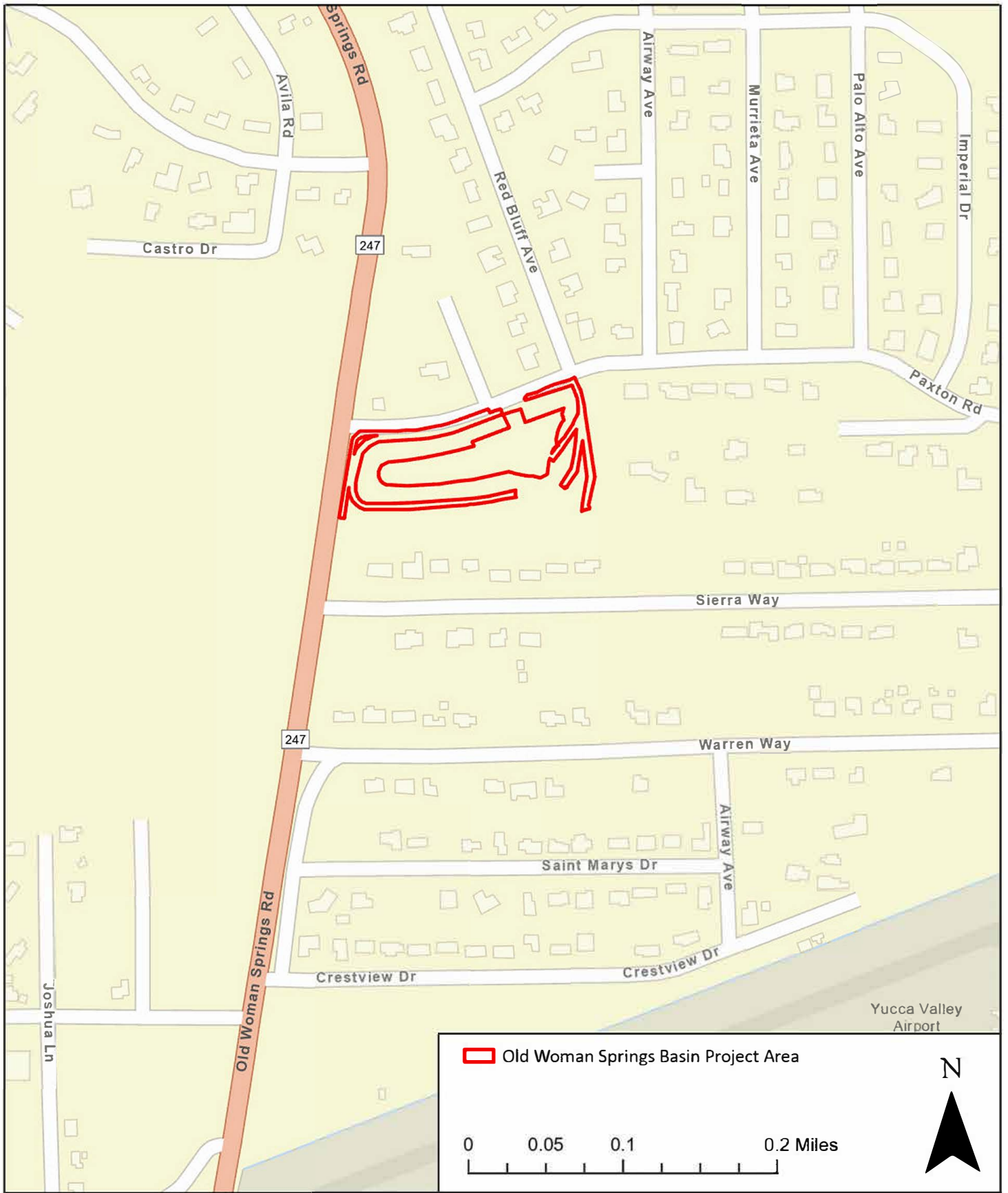
## Burnt Mountain Wash Emergency February 2024



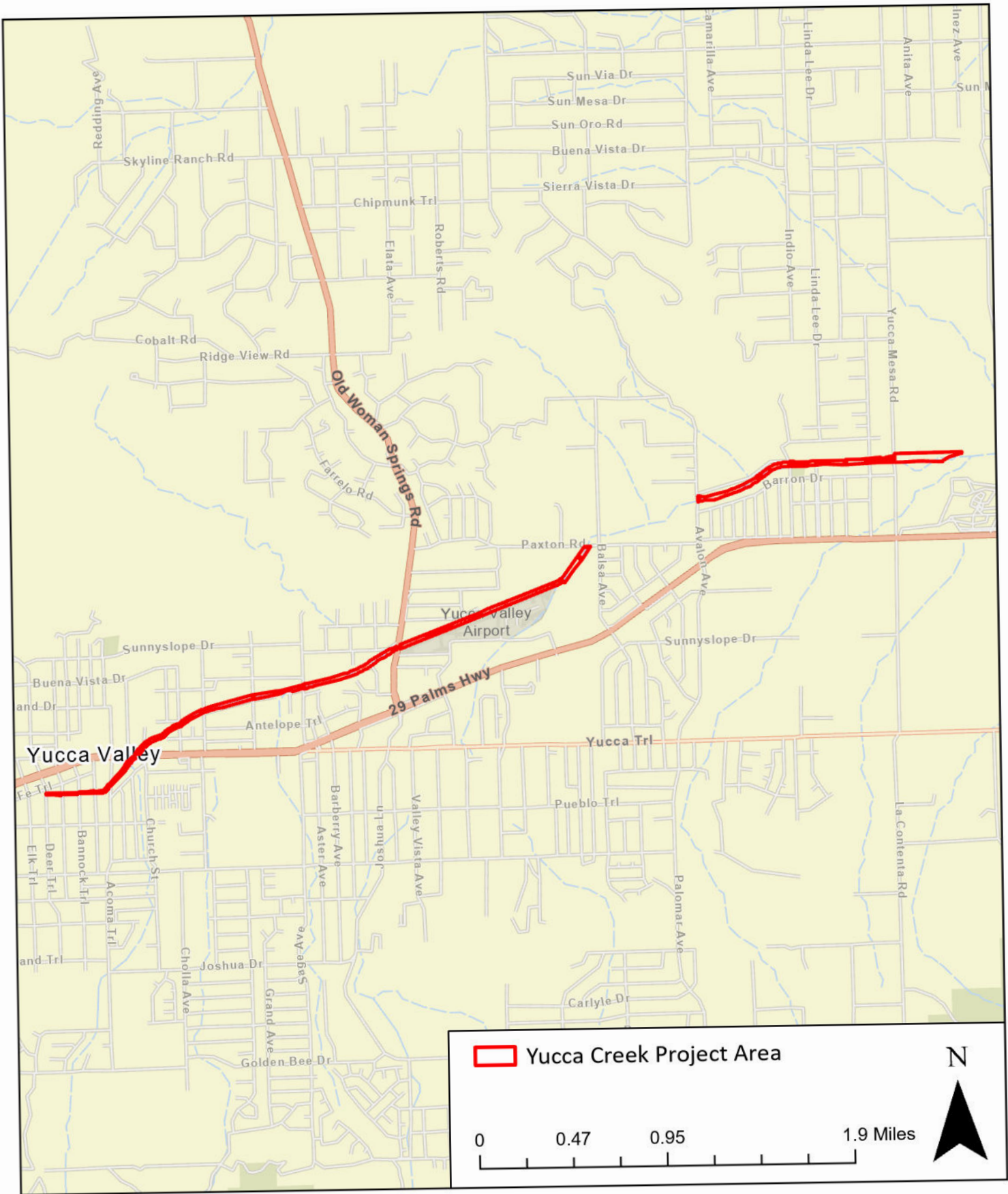
